EFORT virtual General Assembly and New EFORT Board

Due to the persisting global Covid-19 pandemic, EFORT was forced once again to organise its General Assembly virtually. During the meeting that took place on Tuesday, 29 June from 16:00 to 17:30 CEST, the EFORT National Delegates elected new EFORT Board members.

David Limb, United Kingdom was elected as the new Second Vice President for the period 2021/2022. According to the EFORT Statutes, Mr. Limb will then automatically become first Vice President for another year serving as President of EFORT from June 2023 to June 2024.

Rob Nelissen from the Netherlands was elected to serve as new Secretary General for a first period of two years from 2021 to 2023.

Theofilos Karachalios, Greece, current Treasurer, was re-elected for another two years to serve in this position.

To complete the Board elections, the EFORT National Delegates elected Stefan Nehrer from Austria for a first term as Member at Large, also serving as Chair of the EFORT Education Committee, and Filipe Lima Santos from Portugal to be the new Young Member at Large for the period 2021 to 2023.

EFORT Implant and Patient Safety Initiative

Three working groups have been continuing their activities and preliminary results of the initiative are already available.

<u>Group I (Chairs: T. Grupp and S. Overgaard)</u> developed recommendations on the "Introduction of innovations in artificial joint arthroplasty" which are based on a final consensus conference. This conference was held at the Dresden University from 22-23 June 2021. During this conference, voting on the results of research questions was performed, for which data had been extracted in systematic literature reviews done by subgroups. About 50 clinicians, scientists, industry representatives and EFORT National Delegates participated in the working process and contributed with their expertise. The results of the

consensus conference are currently condensed in a manuscript and will soon be published in "EFORT Open Reviews".

In a very similar process, <u>Group II (Chairs: K. Tucker and L. Zagra)</u> finalised a manuscript on "**EFORT-Recommendations for Off-label use, Mix & Match and Mismatch**". All currently available evidence for these important topics was carefully analysed and nearly 40 members of the Steering Group (also including all relevant stakeholders) voted during a final consensus conference, which was organised in a hybrid format on 23 June 2021. A manuscript is currently being submitted to EOR and will be forwarded to all EFORT National Societies upon publication.

The members of <u>Group III (Chairs: E. Gomez-Barrena and M. Morlock)</u> have developed a study protocol, which shall support "**Collection and Analysis of Implants Retrieved during Revision**". As evidence search has shown major procedural heterogeneity in European countries, a prospective collection of implants within a pilot study shall be performed. EFORT National Society members will be invited to participate and contribute to a process of future harmonization.
